|       | 1. Contribute to the World Friendship Fund(National) or the World Scouting Contributions (SHAC) through your den/pack. Learn how this money is used to help Scouts in other parts of the World. (There is <u>no minimum contribution</u> .) | All money collected should be submitted to the Council Service Center   |
|       | 2. Earn the World Conservation Award for your age level ( <u>Wolf or Bear</u> ).  | This Award may only be earned once as a Cub Scout. <i>Wolf Handbook</i> p. 216 and <i>Bear Handbook</i> p. 259.   |
|       | 3. Learn about Lord and Lady Baden Powell and their role in <u>International Scouting</u> . Report to your Den or Pack  | Check the search engines for information or local libraries for books and related material  |
|       | 4. Host an individual or group of foreign students or Scouts at a dinner, a meeting, or a campout weekend where activities are planned so that you learn about their <u>country/countries</u> .   | Prepare a list of questions in advance. Be sure each member of the group has an opportunity to ask at least one question. Check local High Schools for foreign students or exchange programs  |
|       | 5. Plan and execute an international dinner, participate in another international event, or participate in a pack activity involving games from <u>different countries</u>  | If this is done at the pack level, each den may design their table(s) to represent a different country. Decorations could include the nation's flag & map. Samples of the country's food & songs could also be a part of the program. |
|       | 6. Have a Scout or Scouter who has attended an international event or visited an international Scout center visit your den/Pack. Ask him/her questions about their <u>experience</u> .  | Prepare a list of questions in advance. Be sure each member of the group has an opportunity to ask at least one question.   |
