	1. Contribute to the World Friendship Fund(National) or World Scouting Contributions (SHAC) through your den/pack and learn how this money is used to help Scouts in other parts of the world. (There is no <u>minimum contribution</u>).	All money collected should be submitted to the Council Service Center
	2. Complete the requirements for the World Conservation Award for Webelos (even if you earned the award <u>as a Bear or Wolf</u>).	Remember this patch may only be awarded once as a Webelos Scout. <i>Webe/os Handbook</i> p. 436
	3. Learn about the World Organization of Scouting Movement (WOSM). Make a display to share what you learned with <u>others</u> .	http://www.scout.org/international link to World Organization of Scouting Movement
	4. Host an individual or group of foreign students or Scouts at a dinner, a meeting or a campout weekend where activities are planned so that you learn about their <u>country/countries</u> .	Prepare a list of questions in advance. Be sure each member of the group has an opportunity to ask at least one question.
	5. Plan and execute an international dinner, participate in an international event or participate in a pack activity involving games <u>from different countries</u> .	If this is done at the pack level, each den may design their table(s) to represent a different country. Decorations could include the nation's flag & map. Samples of the country's food and songs could also be a part of the program.
	6. Have a Scout or Scouter who has attended an international event or visited an international Scout center visit your den. Ask him/her questions about their <u>experience</u>	Prepare a list of questions in advance. Be sure each member of the group has an opportunity to ask at least one question.
