



TOMAHAWK AWARD NOMINATION

The Tomahawk Award is presented to Scouters who have rendered noteworthy service to youth of Tomahawk District and should have contributed some service to youth in the community outside of Scouting. The service may consist of either a single action that affected a large group of youth in Scouting or service to a small group of youth for an extended period of time. Earning Scouter awards, knots and keys as well as training are taken in consideration, as well as the nominee's attitude toward and cooperation with District and Council. Please note the Tomahawk Award is a prerequisite of the District Award of Merit.

Nomination forms are submitted to the members of the Key 6 by December 31.

The Award Committee consists of the most recent recipients of the District Award of Merit and chaired by earlier recipient. The Tomahawk Award is presented at the District Recognition Dinner in January. If the recipient is not able to attend the dinner, the award will be given to the recipient as soon as possible.
